

How to Become a Sanitary Service Contractor

for Reno County, Kansas

- 1) Review Reno County Sanitation Code
- 2) Complete application
- 3) Pay initial & renewal fees of \$35 for License plus \$35 per truck
- 4) Pass initial & annual truck inspections
- 5) Submit disposal plan that complies with Reno County Sanitation Code & Sludge Regulation Briefing 40 CFR 503 Standard For The Disposal Of Sewage Sludge
- 6) Name & Company contact information will be posted on the Reno County Contractors List & Reno County Website, unless you note you do not want to be public
- 8) Licenses expire December 31st of each year
