Wastewater System Application

A complete description of the requirements for construction of a wastewater system may be found in the Reno County Sanitation Code.

Minimum Setbacks for Wastewater Systems*

- Septic tank/Aerobic unit/Retro fit to foundation of a dwelling -10'
- Soil Absorption system (laterals) to a dwelling foundation –20'

Any part of the wastewater system to:

- Public potable water line-25'
- Private potable water line -10'
- Property line –10' (road right of way may not be included)
- Public water supply well or suction line-100'
- Private water supply well or suction line -50'
- Surface watercourse -50'

Wastewater Lagoons (Lagoon 5' water level)

- Property line -50' (road right of way may not be included)
- Dwelling foundation -50'

Permit Process

(Homeowner/Contractor)						
1. Complete and submit permit application and fee of \$275. (Fee doubles if not paid prior to installation)	Fees and application received. Staff will respond with a proposed date and time for a site evaluation appointment.					
2. Applicant can excavate the soil profile pit. Soil profile analysis may be completed by verified wastewater contractor, county staff, licensed engineer, soil scientist.	Staff conducts site evaluation and possible soil profile. Staff will inform applicant of results and site limitations. Staff will send packet.					
3. Applicant completes construction plan and submits to staff for review and approval. Owner approval required.	Plans received and reviewed for approval of code compliance. Permit issued for approved plans, and permission to begin construction are sent to owner and applicant.					
4. Contact Environmental Division to schedule final inspection of wastewater construction.	Staff conducts and completes final inspection and sends copy of final packet to owner.					

*Any other distances not listed are subject to KDHE interpretation, KDHE Bulletin 4-2, KDHE Article 12 & 30, KDHE Environmental Health Handbook, and amendments thereafter.
